Greetings! And just like that...it's summer! We have enjoyed the warmer weather for sure!

This past quarter has been so busy! Once Memorial Day hit - we have been in a whirlwind! Luke graduated in May! He will be starting Alfred State (NY) in the automotive program at the end of August. He is praying that he can use his skills to help those in need; especially traveling missionaries and evangelists! We had the opportunity to travel throughout NY and PA to give updates to our supporting churches - it was such a blessing to see everyone! We just returned from Maine from special meetings and it was a glorious time! We will be heading back at the beginning of September to visit a new church! With all our travels we are pleased that we can still minister to our people when we are on the road!

TECHNOLOGY:

How we think of ministering to jails and prisons in the year 2022 and beyond must change! Not only in NY, but with many of the jails/prisons we deal with nationwide, they are drastically changing. Covid has ushered in a new way for jails and prisons. Correctional facilities have seen a drastic decrease in contraband and an increase in security measures with having little or NO personal face to face visits. Many (not all) family visits are now done digitally through video and email. Numerous jails are not even letting paper mail go through. For example, in Missouri, they scan all paper mail and then email the letters to individuals in an electronic form. Jails and prison administration are also seeing a decrease in overhead (\$\$\$) with these changes! Money talks - thus things will be staying this way!

So, do we just give up on ministering to those in jails and prisons nationwide because of these changes? Absolutely not! We need to adapt to these changes and allow the Lord to open other doors... and HE HAS! Not only do we work (when we can) with those inside the jails, we now are using technology to reach hundreds of people nationwide! Since our last letter we have increased to close to 600 individuals that we minister to! We work with those in 43 different town/cities in 17 different states!

PRAISE!!! We have solidified a <u>weekly</u> online ZOOM church/bible study with individuals in Tompkins County Jail, NY! We are praying that we can establish relationships with more jails/prisons to hold such services. We thank a good friend for donating a brand new system (microphone) to make the visits heard better!

BIBLES UPDATE:

As the number of individuals we minister increase - so do our King James Bible distribution! Praise the Lord that year to date we have mailed into jails/prisons and to incarcerated family members close to 550 bibles. We have also been contacted by several prisons asking if we could provide bibles! ABSOLUTELY we would! We want the true, infallible Word of God in these places - not some perverted version!!

Black Creek Baptist Church LBB HELPS Ministry:

Volunteers from Black Creek Baptist Church recently prepared 750 bibles to be ready to be sent! Praise the Lord for their willingness to help! We are so very thankful for our home church and all the work they do for LBB!!

UPCOMING TRIPS

We have been blessed to have been invited to several special meetings and mission conferences to present our burden for those behind and beyond jail/prisons across the United States. Typically, we have stayed on the East Coast. However, in September we will be venturing out to Idaho, Indiana, Oklahoma, and Texas! We are humbled by this opportunity and look forward to developing stronger relationships with these churches and extended church family! This month's venture will be our longest and without our son Luke! Please pray for safety, emotional support, and clarity to present the ministry to these churches.
