Greetings! We pray you all had a blessed Resurrection Day!

Although we have been home - we have been very busy presenting the ministry at new local churches and mission conferences! We are pleased that we have received several new church and individual monthly supporters - what a blessing! We did lose a couple churches due to the unfortunate circumstance that their doors have closed. We do have several new churches that we will be presenting the ministry this spring and summer.

Trying to raise monthly support and be home to work the ministry is always a challenge - but we are thankful that we have some men from our church that have helped by going into the jails to preach!

Since I am close to home during the week - I've had several opportunities to make one-on-one visits with individuals in county jails and state prisons. It has been a blessing to minister to them the Word of God and share the hope that they too can have. We've had several men and women ask to be taught on what true bible salvation is and they want a closer relationship with Jesus! These are individuals who want a changed life!

We've also been faced with much disappointment with individuals who made a "jail-house profession" and were making some progress in jail. However, once released, they are either back in jail or have disappeared. They left Jesus at the gate... We are asked to plant and water - and allow the Lord to give the increase. We pray that maybe they will remember something from the Word of God to make them return!

A Place of Refuge Update

WE HAVE A HOME! Praise the Lord that he led us to a home not too far from where we live! The contract has been signed and we are waiting for a date for the closing! We are hoping that when you receive this letter we have already closed on the house! The Lord allowed us to pay cash for the home, in order to not incur any debt. However, we are still raising funds for needed improvements.

GOAL: \$100,000

Why Women:

Most women when they are released from jail or prison are faced with overwhelming obstacles. Many have no where to go except government appointed halfway houses or rescue/homeless shelters. They return to the same unhealthy enviornment which led them to incarceration in the first place. Most of the women have no financial means to support themselves and over 65% do not have a highschool/GED diploma.* Due to no family, friends, or support, more than 68% of these women end up being arrested again within 5 years! **

A Safe Home for Women:

This home will be a residence for women who are looking to establish a new life based on Jesus Christ and avoid harmful environements from their past. Christian values taught from the King James Bible, the Word of God and a commitment to learning, growing, and serving Jesus Christ will be the foundations of this home. The services and structured environment will be adhered to by each resident for the purposes of enriching their top potential in becoming a stable, Christian woman.

How it will look:

We will provide house guidelines that will assist in living with a diverse group of women harmoniously. We are looking to house only 4 women with the hopes of one "house mother." We are praying that either an indvidual who has gone through the training will want to stay and minister to others who come in or that the Lord would put on the heart of a stable, single Christian woman to be the overseer of these 4 women. This overseer would facilitate and coordiante morning and evening devotions, meal preparation and household training, bible studies, and group fellowship. The overseer and LBB would help residents connect with resources for healthcare, employment, education, transportation, and any other mandated court appointed counseling. Women would be required to attend all church services including mid-week prayer night, bible study, and any other special services. LBB will be holding a weekly Christian Addictions class that women will partake in.

This will be a learning process for all of us and I am sure we will adjust things as we go along! Please pray for wisdom!
